Elegantly structured and composed; subtle, smooth fruit and oak integration; melon and some fig; a wondrous back label describing eight aroma and flavour components. Screwcap. 14% alc Rating 90. To 2010 **\$22**

Estate Chardonnay 2007

Fine, elegant stone fruit aromas, with quite a rich a palate, good acidity and a savoury mineral backbone on the finish. Screwcap. 13.5% alc Rating 90. To 2012. **\$18.95**
