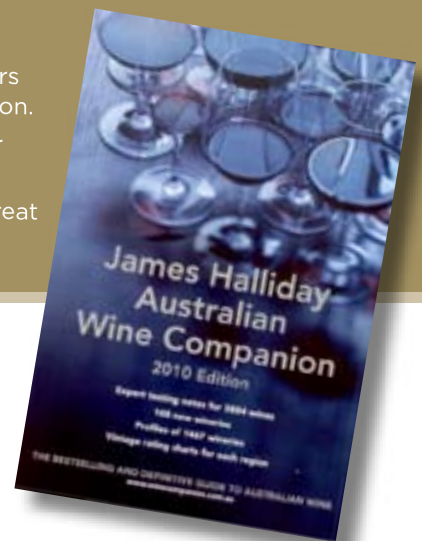

Renowned Australian wine critic and vigneron, James Halliday, has awarded Ferngrove five stars for the sixth consecutive year in the 2010 edition of James Halliday Australian Wine Companion.

Six Ferngrove wines were rated Outstanding (94-100 points) which is a category reserved for wines of the highest quality usually with a distinguished pedigree.

Three Ferngrove wines were Highly Recommended (90-93 points) which denotes wines of great quality, style and character, worthy of a place in any cellar.

2007 Diamond Chardonnay

Elegant, carefully crafted wine; nectarine and melon fruit is supported by some creamy cashew notes and perfectly integrated French oak; carries its alcohol without demur.



94 POINTS

2007 Estate Shiraz

Deep crimson-purple; highly aromatic and saturated with dark plum, blackberry and an array of spices, all making significant inputs to a medium-to full-bodied wine which will age superbly.

2005 The Stirlings

Excellent concentrations of dark berry fruits, with a little dried herb character adding complexity; ample levels of fruit, with plenty of fine-grained tannins providing structure.

2007 Majestic Cabernet Sauvignon

The bouquet has aromas of pure cassis, cedar and an attractive core of savoury black olive; the palate is quite firm and rugged, with toasty oak and plenty of tannin; good levels of sweet fruit eventually take over the structure.

2007 King Malbec

Very good colour; good entry into the mouth, but then that slight dip in the mid-palate typical of malbec; it rises again, with glossy cherry fruit to the fore.

2006 King Malbec

Has far more texture and structure than most malbecs, and the black fruits and Christmas cake flavours avoid the jammy trap; well-deserved gold WA Wine Show '07



90 POINTS

2008 Cossack Riesling

A clean bouquet is followed by a well-balanced palate, with ripe citrus/grapefruit flavours and good acidity.



90 POINTS

2008 Sauvignon Blanc

Restrained but focused and clean aromas and flavours; a firm palate, with good length; nuances of gooseberry throughout.

2007 Symbols Cabernet Merlot

Bright crimson-purple; classic blackcurrant and cassis fruit flavours in a medium-bodied palate; punches well above its weight.
